
LIFE Cushions



All LIFE cushions are specially made for outdoor use. The various fabrics have fillings that have been carefully designed and treated to prevent the growth of mould. One of the most important properties is that they are water-permeable.

Around the filling there is a polyester liner that keeps the shape of the cushion. This polyester cover has an open structure which allows the cushion to breathe and let the water run through.

All cushions have a high colour fastness and are UV-protected.





LIFE All Weather Cushions



The Soft-Touch textilene All-Weather cushions are water permeable and dirt-repellent. This means that the cushions will be wet after rain, but the special inner lining minimises the drying time. By pressing down on the cushions or placing the cushions on their edges, they will be dry in a relatively short period of time.

Using LIFE Outdoor Living – Textilene and Wicker Cleaner ensures that the fabric is well protected and can be cleaned appropriately when necessary. It also ensures that the cushion structure remains "open" and will therefore dry faster.

The cover of the All-Weather cushions is made out of textilene. The anti-bacterial fibre provides long colour fastness and water can be wiped off easily. These cushions can be left outside the entire season but you do need to clean the cushions regularly to make sure it keeps its All-Weather capabilities and to prevent moulding.

To keep them clean and prolong their life, we suggest covering them when not in use and storing indoors for the winter months.

How can All Weather cushions be cleaned?

Cushions can be cleaned with LIFE Outdoor Living Textilene and Wicker Cleaner. This is a non-foaming cleaner for open-woven fabrics and wicker.

The outer cover can also be machine washed at 30 degrees on a gentle wash and with a small amount of laundry detergent. Don not tumble dry or dry clean. It is best to wash one cover at a time.

Refore cushions are bagged and stored for the winter months, or a protection cover is placed over furniture washing.

Before cushions are bagged and stored for the winter months, or a protection cover is placed over furniture with cushions, please ensure that the cushions are completely dry.

LIFE upholstered dining chairs such as Sense or Caribbean chairs can be tilted forward against the table to promote quick and easy draining after rainfall.

What is the warranty for LIFE All Weather cushions?

All 2023 lines offer a 5 year manufacturer's limited warranty. Any furniture manufactured prior to 2018 still carry a 2 year warranty. We always advise that end users keep a proof of purchase when purchasing our furniture to avoid any delay in an event of a warranty claim.

Can replacement cushions be purchased?

Yes, cushion replacements are available, but you should not need to replace any LIFE All Weather cushions for many years unless they have been damaged or experience some other misfortune.

LIFE Soltex Cushions



Sit comfortably on the LIFE Soltex cushions. This cushion combines a polyester fibre with a special softer outdoor thread. The combination of All-Weather and a softer water resistant thread gives the cushion a more natural look and feel, bringing both worlds, interior and exterior, together.

We advise to bring the cushions inside during the winter. Cushions should be completely dry when you store them to prevent them from moulding.

Contrary to the All–Weather cushions, you do need some extra maintenance for these cushions by using an extra protective layer using the LIFE Outdoor Living – Soltex Protector. The protector ensures that your cushion remains protected against dirt and stains.

How can Soltex cushions be cleaned?

We recommend cleaning with LIFE Outdoor Living Soltex Cleaner. For more stubborn dirt the outer cover can be cleaned at 30 degrees in the washing machine, on a gentle wash and with a small amount of laundry detergent. Do not tumble dry or dry clean. It is best to wash one cover at a time.

Before cushions are bagged and stored please ensure that they are completely dry.

What is the warranty for LIFE Soltex cushions?

All 2023 lines offer a 5 year manufacturer's limited warranty. We always advise that end users keep a proof of purchase when purchasing our furniture to avoid any delay in an event of a warranty claim.

Can replacement cushions be purchased?

LIFE Aluminium



LIFE Outdoor Living has a wide range of aluminium furniture. Aluminium has many advantages when used outdoors as it is lightweight and corrosion resistant.

When aluminium is used outdoors, slight surface dirt and a light form of surface corrosion may develop. This is not absorbed into the frame, is not permanent in nature, and can easily be removed.

The high quality powder coating ensures that the products will endure any type of climate as it is UV proof and colourfast. If damage to the paint occurs e.g. scratches, scrapes etc. can be easily retouched.

How is LIFE Aluminium furniture cleaned?

Aluminium furniture can be cleaned using water and a soft soap. Avoid using abrasive or harsh products or sponges. Alternatively, LIFE Outdoor Living Aluminium Cleaner & Protector can be used for cleaning and extra protection.

What maintenance is required?

We recommend that pistons on reclining components and moving mechanisms are occasionally sprayed with e.g. a silicone lubricant to protect and lubricate. Over time, pistons may need adjusting. Please contact Customer Services for support.

What is the warranty on LIFE Aluminium Furniture?

All 2023 lines offer a 5 year manufacturer's limited warranty. Any furniture manufactured prior to 2018 still carry a 2 year warranty. LIFE Teak



Teak is a hardwood which contains a high amount of oil and resin, making the wood naturally water-repellent and therefore suitable for outdoor use. Teak wood is very strong and does not easily damage.

LIFE teak products are all 100% sustainable certified. They work mainly with Indonesian SVLK teak, but also work with FSC certified teak. This means that the full process in manufacturing is registered and monitored.

Normal use of the product will result in small cracks (hairline cracks) and openings appearing in the wood. This does not detract from the quality or the lifespan of the teak, and is characteristic of the charm of this product.

Assembling and moving teak furniture

Table tops should be protected when legs are attached. Please ensure that the top is laid on a soft, protective surface before commencing. After the wood has been in use for a period of time, it may be necessary to occasionally tighten the screws.

When moving heavy teak furniture, do not drag the product as this will damage the joints and leg connections. Claims of this nature will not be covered by the warranty.

Can a protective cover be used on teak furniture?

We advise against using a protective cover for teak furniture as this can lead to the growth of fungi.

What is the warranty on LIFE Teak?

All 2023 lines offer a 5 year warranty against manufacturing faults. Any furniture manufactured prior to 2018 still carry a 2 year warranty. We always advise that end users keep a proof of purchase when purchasing our furniture to avoid any delay in an event of a warranty claim. Please ask for full details of our warranty and refer to this for claim information.









Before using any maintenance product on teak, the surface needs to be clean and dry. We discourage the use of any aggressive detergents or pressure cleaners. If you wish to use a different cleaner, always test the effect of this in a hidden spot.

How is LIFE Robust Teak furniture cleaned?

LIFE Outdoor Living Teak Cleaner can be used for intensive cleaning of weathered teak, and will kill fungi and algae within the teak wood. Simply follow the instructions on the bottle and the colour of new teak will be restored. It is important when treating teak that you work along the direction of the grain for the best results.


To keep the colour of new teak and prevent weathering, the wood can then be painted with LIFE Robust Teak Protector.

How often should the LIFE Robust Teak be treated?

When the surface of the wood starts to feel rough it is time to treat your teak with LIFE Robust Teak Protector. A thin layer should be applied and left to soak into the wood. If too much is used, the colour will run off the surface and could stain chairs, patios etc. Once dry, treat with Teak Shield to repel moisture and protect against mould and mildew.

Because it takes some time and effort to clean teak, we recommend using LIFE Teak Shield at least 2-3 times a year.

During the teak manufacturing process LIFE Teak Shield is applied. To account for the time taken for shipping and purchase, we suggest that the LIFE Teak Shield is reapplied directly after purchase.





LIFE Polywood



Polywood is a sustainable product which has the appearance of wood due to its artificial pressed grain. It is low maintenance, lightweight and will not splinter.

How is LIFE Polywood cleaned?

Polywood can be cleaned using LIFE Outdoor Living Polywood Cleaner. Any dried on dirt or debris can be loosened by using water and a soft-bristle brush. Application of the LIFE Outdoor Living Polywood Protector will create a protective layer and help prevent stains and marks.

What is the warranty on LIFE furniture with polywood features?

All 2023 lines offer a 5 year manufacturer's limited warranty. Any furniture manufactured prior to 2018 still carry a 2 year warranty. We always advise that end users keep a proof of purchase when purchasing our furniture to avoid any delay in an event of a warranty claim. Please ask for full details of our warranty and refer to this for claim information.

Hot items such as pans, candles or hot drinks should not be left on polywood surfaces. Do not leave glasses on the surface in the hot sun. Due to its "magnifying glass" effect it can damage the polywood by burning into the material.









Spraystone is a mixture of ground natural stone and high-quality resin sprayed onto a glass plate. Because this mixture is sprayed professionally as a layer onto tempered glass, the result is a lightweight table top that cannot be distinguished from genuine hard stone. The sides of the table tops also have the same finish to reinforce the luxury appearance.

How are LIFE Spraystone table tops cleaned?

Spraystone should be cleaned with LIFE Outdoor Living Spraystone Cleaner. Alternatively, the surface can be cleaned using tepid water and a soft sponge (NEVER use hard detergents or abrasive scourers).

We recommend that LIFE Outdoor Living Spraystone Protector is used to apply an extra protective layer.

In addition to cleaning, do not leave products on the table for long periods of time as they can cause the spraystone to lighten, leaving a mark. Ensure that protection covers are not left with water standing on top as this can also cause the spraystone to fade. Do not use e.g. candles or tealights on the surface without protecting the spraystone as they can become hot and cause irremovable stains.

LIFE recommend to remove protection covers regularly to allow air to circulate around the spraystone.

Please note that LIFE tables may include generic fixings for all **LIFE** table top options. Customers may not need to use all screws etc. included.

LIFE Ceramic Table Tops



LIFE's ceramic table tops have a remarkable strength and is one of the hardest materials used in garden furniture. It has an extremely high scratch threshold, is UV proof and colour fast, and it is easy to maintain.

Ceramic—Tempered Glass

These 8mm thick low maintenance table tops are available in multiple sizes and can be combined with most of the LIFE tables, including coffee tables, dining tables and even the bar tables.

Tempered glass is carefully sprayed with 2-3 layers of ceramic to produce this hardwearing and attractive top.

Ceramic—Honeycomb

Tables with a thicker table top are made of a honeycomb aluminium base. The ceramic panels are glued to the base to create a solid table top.

Please note that LIFE tables may include generic fixings for all LIFE table tops. Customers may not need to use all screws etc. included.

Ceramic tops can be cleaned using LIFE Ceramic Cleaner & Protector. Alternatively, the surface can be cleaned using tepid water and a soft sponge.

LIFE Outdoor Living offers a range of protection covers for their lounge and dining sets. All LIFE protection covers are 100% ripstop polyester and feature a breathable membrane to transport condensation outwards, whilst simultaneously preventing dust and dirt from getting in.

Which protection cover will fit?

Please note, to distinguish right from left: if when seated on the element the armrest is on your left side, the side is called left.

How are the protection covers secured?

There are a number of buckles and toggles on each cover to ensure optimal protection from the elements. Please ensure the cover is correctly secured, as weather damage is not covered by the manufacturer's limited warranty.

If the cover is supplied with a pop up cone, place it on the table top under the cover to reduce contact with the table surface.

What warranty is offered with LIFE protection covers?

All **LIFE** protection covers carry a 3 year manufacturer's limited warranty. We always advise that end users keep a proof of purchase when purchasing our furniture to avoid any delay in an event of a warranty claim.

Regularly remove any standing water from protection covers on LIFE tables as prolonged contact with e.g. spraystone can affect the table surface below.
